- (a) and (b) This Ministry had taken up the issue of enhancing the total Gross Budgetary Support (GBS) outlay for the Central Sector Roads during the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17) with the Planning Commission. However, the proposal has been turned down by Planning Commission in view overall resource constraints.
- (c) and (d) A provision of Rs. 64,834 crore has been made towards Internal and Extra Budgetary Resources (IEBR) for development of National Highways (NHs) under National Highways Development Project (NHDP) during the 12th Five Year Plan.
