STOPPAGE OF TRAINS AT BARABANKI RAILWAY STATION

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Railways have received representations regarding the stoppage of some important trains at Barabanki Railway station in view of its religious importance;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Railways thereto;
- (c) whether a demand has been made to the Railways for providing stoppage for Durg Express at Bilthara Road and Salempur in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Railways thereto?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Madam. The request has been examined but not found feasible.
- (c) & (d) Yes, Madam. Stoppage of 8201/8202 Durg-Gorakhpur Express has been provided at Belthara Road, w.e.f. 25-01-2009, on an experimental basis till 31-03-2010. However, stoppage of 8201/8202 Durg-Gorakhpur Express at Salempur station has not been found feasible.
