(a) to (d): The National Police Mission under the Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) have prepared a plan proposal on 'Community Policing for Students' on the basis of the Student Police Cadet model of Kerala, for implementation in selected States during the 12th Five Year Plan on pilot basis. The proposal prepared by BPR&D has been received in the Ministry of Home Affairs. Its implementation is subject to availability of funds, consent of State Governments and acceptance of other agencies, who are proposed to be engaged in the project implementation.
