Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have been able to earn more revenue from the cancellation of e-tickets;
- (b) if so, the amount earned by the Railways on this account for the last three years;
- (c) whether the Railways are earning hefty revenue from the cancellation of tatkal tickets as well; and
- (d) if so, the amount earned by the Railways from the cancellation of tatkal tickets during the last three years?

Answer

(a) & (b): The cancellation charges (including clerkage charges) recovered during the last three years on account of cancellation of e-tickets (including Tatkal tickets) were approximately 1101.98 crores.

(c) & (d): The cancellation charges (including clerkage charges) recovered during the last three years on account of cancellation of Tatkal tickets were approximately `165.76 crores.
