(a) & (b) Damage to antipoaching camps, offices, rest houses and communication towers by Naxalites was reported only in the Similipal Tiger Reserve of Odisha during 2009. A special team was sent by the National Tiger Conservation Authority, for a field appraisal in this regard, and under the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Project Tiger, funding assistance is provided for protection and management of the Similipal Tiger Reserve. Further, under the said Scheme, 100% central assistance has been provided for raising, arming and deploying the Special Tiger Protection Force.
