Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to promote generic medicines in the interest of common people for their use;
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Government for availability of generic medicines;
- (c) whether the Government has identified the formulations of generic medicines in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether any action proposed to be taken by the Government against the doctors who are not prescribing the generic medicines and if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) to (e): Yes, Sir. The Government has opened 154 Jan Aushadhi Drug Stores (JADS) in various States / UTs for selling generic drugs at reasonable prices to the common man. The Government has been requesting State /UT administration to assist in opening more and more JADS. A total of 319 medicines including formulation have been identified for sale at these JADS. Wherever Jan Aushadhi Stores have been opened, the concerned State Government have been issuing instructions / guidelines to their Doctors in the Government Hospitals to prescribe generic medicines. Similar instructions are also reported to have been issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to the Doctors to prescribe medicines in generic names.
