STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 424 FOR ANSWER ON 25.04.2013.

- (a)to(c): Government in the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), as such, does not carry out assessment of implementation of schemes to promote Agro and Rural Industries (ARI) sector. However, Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) and Coir Board who implement these schemes get them duly evaluated through independent agencies for their continuation in the next Five Year Plan and their finding, observations and recommendations (including any shortcomings noticed) are duly taken into consideration for deciding their continued implementations in succeeding Five Year Plan. As per the Terms of Reference (ToRs) of evaluation, there is no separate provision for capturing State/UT-wise data on implementations except Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP). The State-wise data on performance of PMEGP, the major scheme of ARI sector during XI Plan is given in Annex.
- (d): No significant trend of any agro and rural industries being on the verge of closure has come to the notice of the Ministry.
- (e): Does not arise.
