- (a) whether cases of missing persons are increasing in the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the total number of such cases registered along with the number of men, women and children traced/untraced separately, and the steps taken to trace all the missing persons during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to evolve a mechanism for recording of missing/found persons in coordination with the Delhi Police; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?
