Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) personnel killed in the line of duty during each of the last three years and the current year, force-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has granted martyr/shaheed status of such CAPF personnel;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Union Government has made consultations with the State Governments in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details and the outcome thereof?

(a): Total number of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) personnel killed in the line of duty during each of the last three years and the current year, force-wise are as under:

(b) to (e): Martyr/Shahed is not defined by the Government anywhere and presently no order /notification are being issued for the CAPF personnel to give status of Martyr/Shahed who killed in the line of duty. In view of the above, no consultation with the State Governments seems necessary.
