(a): Yes, Madam.

(b): a total of Rs. 38.20 lakhs has been seized and 11 bank accounts frozen by NIA during the investigation of three cases. All the cases are under trial stage.

Government has constituted a Terror Funding & Fake Currency Cell(TFFC) in the National Investigation Agency (NIA) to focus on Terror Funding and Fake Currency Cases. Government is also pursuing/monitoring these cases closely for expeditious trial and prosecution.
