- (a) Whether the transport bodies have found any roadway flaws in the Gurgaon-Faridabad-Agra stretch on National Highway (NH)-2;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government to remove the said flaws?

(a) to (c) No, Madam. However, six-laning of Faridabad-Agra section of NH-2 has already been awarded and the scope of work covers improvement works related to road safety and other identified roadway flaws during DPR stage. Gurgaon-Faridabad road is not a National Highway and hence comes under the purview of the concerned State Governments.
