- (a): No allocation of fund is made city-wise. The 7 years' allocation for the State of Gujarat is Rs.2078.81 crore for Urban Infrastructure & Governance (UIG) of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission(JNNURM). In 2008-09, additional allocation was provided to all Mission Cities including those of Gujarat. Under the above provision, an additional amount of Rs.100 crore for all Million Plus Cities and State Capitals and Rs.50.00 crore for other cities was allocated under UIG of JNNURM.
