- (c) the reasons for getting the BSNL internet connection inspite of facility of railtel at said station; and
- (d) the reaction of the Railways thereto?

- (a) No internet connection is required. Tatkal tickets are being issued from Baripada Railway Computerised booking centre at an average of 31 tickets per day.
