(a) to (e): Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices (CACP) has submitted its Report on Price Policy for Kharif Crops of 2013-14 Season recommending Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) of kharif crops, including paddy.

The Government finalises the MSPs recommended by CACP after consultation with the State Governments and concerned Central Ministries/Departments.
