- (c) the budgetary allocations and expenditure for the KVKs since 2009;
- (d) whether the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) is supporting the functioning of KVKs; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) There are 632 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) in the country.
- (c) The year-wise details of budgetary allocations and expenditure for the KVKs since 2009 are given in the Annexure.
- (d) Yes, Madam.

(e) The ICAR is providing 100 percent financial assistance for 16 staff; building infrastructure depending upon its needs including main building, a trainees' hostel, two demonstration units and six residential apartments; fencing and farm development; purchase of vehicles, equipments, implements and instructional aids; and recurring contingencies. Besides, the eight Zonal Project Directorates of ICAR provide technical, administrative and policy guidance, and review and monitor the activities of KVKs.
