- (a) whether the Union Government has absorbed 52 agriculture related schemes into seven major schemes during the 12th Five Year Plan period:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether a Committee had been constituted under the chairmanship of B.K. Chaturvedi to review the entire Centrally Sponsored Schemes and suggest potential ways of their consolidation to bring significant reduction in their number;
- (d) if so, whether the aforesaid Committee has submitted its report to the Union Government;
- (e) if so, the outcome thereof; and
- (f) the action taken by the Union Government thereon?

- (a) & (b): 51 schemes of the Department of Agriculture & Cooperation are being restructured into five missions, five central sector schemes and one state plan scheme in order to have focused approach in 12th Plan. Details of these Missions/schemes are at annexure.
- (c) & (d): Yes, Madam. Planning Commission had constituted a Sub-Committee under the Chairmanship of Shri B.K. Chaturvedi, to look into the restructuring of Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) to enhance its flexibility, scale and efficiency. The Committee had submitted its report in September, 2011.
- (e) & (f): Considering the recommendations of Chaturvedi Committee Report and 12th Plan Document, schemes of the Department are being restructured.
