- (a) & (b): Yes Madam. Government of Maharashtra had appointed a Fast Track Court presided over by an Additional Session Judge for conducting the trials relating to Somalian Pirates.
- (c) to (d): No Madam. This Ministry has not received any proposal to free Samalian pirates in return of abducted Indian sailors.
