(a) Yes, Madam.

(b) and (c) The proposal was included under the proposed Road Requirement Plan (RRP) Phase-II for development of road network in Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected areas. The RRP Phase-II was included in the draft 12th Five Year Plan. However, due to paucity of funds, the scheme could not find place in the Final 12th Five Year Plan.
