(a) whether the condition of various stretches of National Highway (NH) Nos. 86 and 26 passing through the State of Madhya Pradesh is very dilapidated;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has taken steps for the repair of said NHs during the last three years and the current year; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) and (b) NH 26 and NH 86 passing through the State of Madhya Pradesh are generally in traffic worthy condition except a few stretches where development and maintenance works are in various stages of progress.

(c) and (d) Maintenance and repair is a continuous process and are taken up depending upon availability of funds and inter-se priority.
