Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the condition of various stretches of National Highway (NH) Nos. 86 and 26 passing through the State of Madhya Pradesh is very dilapidated;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken steps for the repair of said NHs during the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

- (a) and (b) NH 26 and NH 86 passing through the State of Madhya Pradesh are generally in traffic worthy condition except a few stretches where development and maintenance works are in various stages of progress.
- (c) and (d) Maintenance and repair is a continuous process and are taken up depending upon availability of funds and inter-se priority.
