- (d) the time by which these are likely to be granted?

- (a)&(b) The Ministry has not received any proposals for setting up of new wildlife sanctuaries from the State Governments including Government of Bihar. However, proposals for setting up of following new zoos during 2012-13 have been received by the Central Zoo Authority.
- i. New Zoological Park at Udhayagiri Fort at Kalkulam Village of Kanyakumari District, Tamil Nadu.
- ii. Siberian Crane Semi-captive Exhibit Centre at Keoladeo National Park, Bharatpur, Rajasthan.
- iii. Amphibian Park and Rodent Park at Naga, North Sikkim, Sikkim.

No proposal for setting up of new zoo in Bihar has been received.

(c)&(d) No proposal is lying pending with Central Zoo Authority. Proposals for a new Zoological Park at Udhayagiri Fort at Kalkulam Village of Kanyakumari District, Tamil Nadu and Siberian Crane Semi-captive Exhibit Centre at Keoladeo National Park, Bharatpur, Rajasthan are under scrutiny for consideration.
