(a) whether the ancient 'Akshay Vat' tree is located in the historical fort of Akbar in Allahabad which is under control of the Indian Army;

(b) whether Indian Army is likely to hand over the historical fort of Akbar to the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI);

(c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be handed over to ASI; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI A.K. ANTONY)

(a) Yes, Madam. There are two 'Akshay Vat' trees located in the historical fort of Akbar in Allahabad, also known as OD Fort.

(b) There is no such proposal to hand over the Fort to Archaeological Survey of India (ASI).

(c) Does not arise.

(d) The OD Fort is an important Military installation and hence it would not be feasible to hand over the same to ASI.
