Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been a delay in declaration of results in Calicut University Centres in Lakshadweep;

(b) if so, whether such delays adversely affect the students who pursue courses there; and

(c) if so, the steps being taken by the Government to ensure that results are published on time?

Answer

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. As per information furnished to us by the Calicut University, there has been some delay in the declaration of results of the examination of the first batch of undergraduate programme under the Choice Based Credit Semester System (CBCSS), held in April 2012, in affiliated colleges including centres in Lakshwadeep. The changes in the undergraduate curriculum consequent upon introduction of the CBCSS from the 2009 admission batch onwards, resulted in some delay in the declaration of results of the first batch of students who completed the programme in 2012. The university has informed us that it has taken all possible measures to publish the results of the examination in time.

The Calicut University is a State University established by an Act of the State Legislature and therefore is outside the administrative purview of the Central Government.
