(a): The 12th Plan seeks to achieve greater access to higher education coupled with equity and inclusion. It also seeks to enhance quality and excellence in all spheres of higher education. (b) to (d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) gives grants to those institutions which are covered under Section 2(f) and are fit to receive such grants under Section 12B of the UGC Act, 1956. The UGC had constituted an Expert Committee under the chairmanship of Prof. S.P Thyagarajan to develop a new funding pattern for the universities and colleges based on transparent, objective norms. The Committee has since finalized and submitted its report to the UGC.
