(a) & (b): No Madam. The Planning Commission has not recommended introduction of a new cess for funding universal healthcare to offer cashless healthcare to all sections of the society. However, the 12th Five Year Plan proposes the introduction of a designated sin tax to finance a part of the health budget which can lead to reduced consumption of harmful items such as tobacco and alcohol.
