The factory-wise targets and achievements for last three years including Vehicle Factory Jabalpur are given in Annexure-I. The targets have by and large been achieved except in a few factories. The details are given in Annexure-II.

The review of performance of various Ordnance Factories is carried out on a regular basis at Ordnance Factory Board. The last performance review was done on 19th & 20th November 2009. Performance is also being reviewed by the Ministry of Defence regularly.

As indicated above, performance of the factories is being monitored regularly to ensure capacity utilization. Action has also been taken to modernize the factories and to upgrade the level of technology to meet the requirements of the armed forces.

Ordnance Factories are mainly intended for meeting the requirements of the armed forces. The available spare capacity, if any, is utilized for exports.
