(a) to (c): Considering the existing lacunae of an institutional mechanism at the Central level for promotion of voluntary action, research, training and documentation within the domain of women, Ministry of Women & Child Development has earmarked allocation for initiating work on setting up of a National Institute of Women Affairs. Since, the preparations are at conceptual stage, it is premature to provide the details and the time frame for operationalising the same.
