- (a) whether there are sufficient number of child care/day care centres for the young children of working mothers and women belonging to poor families in the country particularly rural areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) if not, whether the Government proposes to set up adequate number of such centers; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): The Ministry of Women and Child Development is implementing the "Rajiv Gandhi National CrÃ"che Scheme for the Children of Working Mothers", (RGNCS) as a Central Sector Scheme, for setting up and maintenance of crÃ"ches to provide day care facilities to the children, in the age group of 0-6 years, of families with monthly income of less than Rs.12,000/-. The State/UT-wise details of crÃ"ches is given in Annex.
- (c): New crà ches are not being sanctioned by the Government at present.
- (d): Does not arise in view of reply to (c) above.
