Army Welfare Housing Organisation (AWHO) has constructed 20,279 houses at various stations in the country. Construction of 3,405 Dwelling Units have also been taken up.

2. AWHO constructs houses at a particular station based on demand and availability of land. In absence of adequate demand for housing projects from army personnel/availability of land at reasonable rates, such projects have not been taken up in the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura.
