(a) whether the State Government of Gujarat has forwarded a proposal for improvement of 965 kms. of border road on 30 May, 2009; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government thereon?

(a) & (b): Government has approved, in November, 2010, a proposal for construction of Gadhuli-Hajipur-Santalpur road of about 255 km. (122km. new road and 133 km. to be upgraded) at an estimated cost of Rs. 550.00 Cr. Gujarat Road and Buildings Department (GRBD), which is the executing agency for these works, has completed work to the extent of 130 km. for up- gradation of existing roads. The agency has prepared Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for construction of new roads of 122 km. for execution of work.
