(a)& (b) Government of Madhya Pradesh had submitted eight project proposals, which were approved by the Department with a total outlay of Rs.3806.62 lakh covering 18 districts namely, Guna, Narsinghpur, Khargaon, Chhatarpur, Satna, Rewa, Jhabua, Chhindwara, Balaghat, Harda, Barwani, Neemuch, Sheopur, Seoni, Dewas, Dhar, Khandwa and Betul under the scheme Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP). An amount of Rs.2623.16 lakh has been released under the approved projects as on 30.04.2013. Details are as under:
