(a) to (c) The Government is not establishing any Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the country including Hyderabad under Vocational Training Improvement Project with the assistance of World Bank. However, Government has taken up upgradation of 400 existing Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) from 33 States/ Union Territories including 25 ITIs from Andhra Pradesh under World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP). These ITIs are under different stages of modernisation and are functional.
