- (a) whether the Government proposes to re-construct bridge across Girna River on old National Highways (NH) No. 3, Malegaon city of Maharashtra State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has held any discussion with the State Government of Maharashtra in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government for expeditious completion of this project?

Answer

- (a) & (b) This Ministry has given in-principal approval for re-construction of the major bridge across Girna River in Malegaon district on old NH-3, under Inter State Connectivity Scheme.
- (c) & (d) Under Inter State Connectivity Scheme, after in-principal approval, State Government submits estimate for sanction. So far state Government of Maharashtra has not submitted the estimate in the Ministry. Once the estimate is received, it will be processed based on interse priority and availability of funds.
