DEVELOPMENT OF ROADS IN LEFT WING EXTREMISM LWE AFFECTED AREAS .

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has approved Road Requirement Plan (RRP) for development of roads in Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected areas of various States;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Odisha and present status of works under the Plan;

(c) the State-wise details of the expenditure incurred/likely to be incurred on the said plan and the time-frame fixed for completion of the same ;

(d) whether the Government has received any proposals for taking up the work under the said plan on priority basis and if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI SARVEY SATHYANARAYANA)

(a) to (c) Yes Madam. In February, 2009, Government has approved Road Requirement Plan (RRP) for development of 5477 km roads in Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected areas in 8 States at an estimated cost of Rs. 7300 crore. All the projects are scheduled for completion by March, 2015. The State-wise details of the works approved under Plan including Odisha and the expenditure incurred thereon are as under:
