(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): The Navigational / Landing aids installed and maintained by Airports Authority of India (AAI) at various Indian Air Force (IAF) airfields (Civil KncJaves), are adequate for civil flight operations. The details of Navigational Aids installed and maintained by AAI at IAF airfields are at Annex.

(b)to (d) : Yes, Madam. AAI has already requested the State Government of I'ttar Pradesh to provide SO acres of land for development of a new civil enclave at Bamrauli airport which is in Allahabad, not in Ahmedabad.
