**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of airfields within the campuses of Indian Air Force which have adequate infrastructure and ILS system;
- (b) whether there is a proposal for developing a civilian enclave with proper infrastructure for handling civilian operations at Bamrauli airport in Ahmedabad;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI K. C. VENU GOPAL)

(a): The Navigational / Landing aids installed and maintained by Airports Authority of India (AAI) at various Indian Air Force (IAF) airfields (Civil Enclaves), are adequate for civilian flight operations. The details of Navigational Aids installed and maintained by AAI at IAF airfields are at Annex.

(b) to (d) : Yes, Madam. AAI has already requested the State Government of Uttar Pradesh to provide 50 acres of land for development of a new civilian enclave at Bamrauli airport which is in Allahabad, not in Ahmedabad.
