(a), (b), (c) & (d): No, Madam. Government of India has granted `in principle approval to Government of Maharashtra for establishment of an international airport at Navi Mumbai in July, 2007 through Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. Government of Maharashtra has identified City and Industrial Development Corporation of Maharashtra Ltd. (CIDCO) as the nodal agency to implement the project. The airport project will be constructed by a Concessionaire who will be selected through global bidding
