(a) & (b): The Medical Council of India, with the prior approval of the Central Government, has amended `Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations, 1998` thereby enhancing age limit for appointment/extension/re-employment in-service against posts of teachers/dean/principal/director in medical colleges from 65 to 70 years. It is for the appropriate recruitment authorities to avail the benefit of above relaxation.
