- (a) whether the Union Government is aware of the anchoring of the Ship 'River Princess' near Candolin in Goa for the last nine years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Union Government to break/dispose the said ship?

- (a)&(b): As per the information provided by various agencies like the Government of Goa; Ministry of Environment & Forest; Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) (Central Board of Excise and Customs) etc., it is intimated that the vessel M.V.River Princess grounded off Sinquerim Beach, Candolim on 6-6-2000.
- (c) A Court case is pending in the High Court of Bombay in respect of the ship River Princess. The Government of Goa are required to take necessary action to break/dispose of the said ship by following the orders of the High Court as well as the procedure approved by the Supreme Court of India.
