Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the consumption of iron ore in the country;
- (b) whether the pricing policy of iron ore for long-term contracts and in spot markets needs a re-look;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Union Government proposes to control the prices of iron ore in view of its limited availability; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL(SHRI A. SAI PRATHAP)

- (a) As per estimates of Ministry of Steel, about 87 million tonnes of iron ore was consumed in the country during 2008-09, out of production of about 227.64 million tonnes#.
- (b)&(c): Iron ore is in de-regulated sector and Government has no role to play in fixing the iron-ore prices either in long term contracts or in spot market. It is the market demand and supply situation which determines iron ore prices.
- (d)&(e): Presently, no proposal regarding controlling the prices of iron ore is under consideration in Ministry of Steel.
