- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) Four railway stations have been identified in Rajasthan under this Scheme.
- (c) & (d) In Works programme 2009-10, it is proposed to implement this scheme at 195 sensitive stations of the Country at an estimated cost of Rs.344.31 Crore. Efforts will be made to complete it early subject to availability of resources.
