Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to develop/upgrade an international sea port at Dhubri in Assam;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Assam in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the time by which a final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF SHIPPING (SHRI G.K. VASAN)

- (a)&(b):There is no proposal to construct international sea port at Dhubri in Assam. At present Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) maintains a floating terminal at Dhubri. A project for construction of an Inland Water Transport (IWT) terminal with Roll on Roll off (Ro-Ro) facility at Dhubri has been sanctioned at an estimated cost of Rs. 31.08 crore and the work has been awarded by IWAI to Central Public Works Department (CPWD).
- (c) No proposal has been received from the State Government of Assam to develop/ upgrade terminal at Dhubri as an international sea port.
- (d)&(e): Does not arise.
