- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the implementation of Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement project by different States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the State-wise details of fund allocated and utilized?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER FOR WATER RESOURCES (SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a) & (b) A Technical Committee (TC) constituted by Ministry of Water Resources under the Chairmanship of Member (Design & Research), Central Water Commission (CWC), involving the nodal officers of each State implementing agency reviewed the implementation of the Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP) on quarterly basis to take stock of the progress and to remove bottlenecks in project implementation. The TC has expressed satisfaction in the momentum gained by DRIP in the physical progress. DRIP being a World Bank funded Project, the financial progress of the project is also being monitored by the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance.

(c) As per information available, the state wise details of fund allocation and utilization till end of June 2013 is as under:
