DIGITISATION OF DL AND RC DRIVING LICENSES AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES .

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has started digitisation of all Driving Licenses (DLs) and Vehicle Registration Certificates (RCs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the DLs and RCs digitised/made available online so far;
- (c) whether the Government also proposes to digitise the old data of all Regional Transport Offices across the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the progress made so far in this regard?

Answer

(a) & (b) The number of digitised DL and RC records is given below:

DL Records: 4,50,70,530.

RC Records: 11,75,23,489.

(c) & (d) Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has requested Transport Departments of States/Union Territories to undertake digitisation of legacy data of Registration Certificates and Driving Licences. The Ministry will reimburse the Transport Departments @ Rs.5/- per record (Rs.7/- per record in the case of States/UTs having difficult terrain) to incentivise digitisation of legacy data.
