As regards, the construction of 2nd coaching terminal at Sabarmati station, the same has been included in the Budget 2013-14 at an anticipated cost of `29.60 crore. Preliminary activities for preparation of plan, estimate, etc, have been taken up. Target date for completion has not yet been fixed.
