- (a) whether the Railways propose doubling of railway line between Alwar and Bandikui under North-Western Railway (NWR) in view of the completion of work on Jaipur to Bandikui and Rewari to Alwar section;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said work is likely to be started and completed?

(a) to (c): Alwar-Bandikui doubling (60.37 km) project has been included in Railway Budget 2013-14 at an anticipated cost of Rs. 242.09 crore. An amount of Rs 0.5 crore has been provided to it during 2013-14. Preliminary activities including Final Location Survey, etc. and preparation of estimate taken up. Target Date of Completion cannot be fixed at this stage.

The project will be completed in coming years subject to availability of resources.
