FAKE APPOINTMENT LETTERS

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken note of the reported incidents of poor unemployed youths being duped on the pretext of job opportunities at All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi through fake appointment letters by some unscrupulous elements engaged in the job racket;
- (b) if so, the details of such incidents reported during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) whether the Government has taken/ proposed any steps to prevent the recurrence of such incidents;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (e): One such incident had come to notice in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi on 15/06/2013. The matter was forwarded to Station House Officer, Police Station Hauz Khas, New Delhi on the same day and subsequently F.I.R. no. 236/2013, under section 420, 468 and 471/34 of Indian Penal Code was registered on 17/06/2013.
