(a) to (c): "Leather / skin / hide processing industry" is one of the activities which require prior Environment Clearance (EC) under the Environment Impact Assessment Notification (EIA), 2006, as amended from time to time. The EC for an activity or project under the EIA Notification is given after following prescribed procedure. The EC is given subject to various conditions and environmental safeguards including Environment Management Plan.

There is no proposal under consideration for setting up of a special Environment Impact Assessment Committee to assess the environmental damage created by leather tanning industries in the country.
