The ideas of eminent social reformers and freedom fighters are amply reflected in the textbooks taught in CBSE affiliated schools. Recently, CBSE approved course:- Traditional Knowledge Practice of India, which teaches the students about our country's ancient wisdom. These textbooks also undergo regular review and revision of their subject matter based on the evolving consensus in the academic community.
