**Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:**

- (a) the names of the Livestock Insurance Scheme (LIS) being run in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the amount of funds disbursed and the number of individuals covered under the LIS in 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13;
- (c) whether the Union Government has considered relaxation of norms in areas chronically affected by floods, droughts and other such natural disasters;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has received any proposals or representations from the State Government in this regard; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Union Government thereto?

**Answer**

- (a) The Livestock Insurance Scheme is being implemented with the same nomenclature in 28 States of the country.
- (b) The amount of funds disbursed and the number of individuals covered under Livestock Insurance Scheme during 2010-11, 2011-12 & 2012-13 are as follows:
